

Driving Efficiency in Investigational Drug Services



Virginia Cancer Specialists (VCS), the largest private oncology practice in Northern Virginia, runs over 150 active research studies and leads the region's largest Phase I drug development program. As VCS Research Institute expanded, paper-based accountability logs became unmanageable for its small pharmacy team.

In September 2022, VCS implemented Vestigo® to automate investigational drug management, enabling real-time oversight, streamlined documentation, and improved compliance.

Key Challenges

- Limited Staffing:** Only one pharmacist and one technician are managing a growing study portfolio
- Bulky Paper Binders:** Inefficient, space-consuming, and error-prone
- Inefficient Monitor Prep:** Time-intensive scanning and emailing
- No Standardization:** Inconsistent documentation across protocols
